(these PSUs vest at various dates through March 1, 2022 contingent upon the achievement of pre-established performance targets over a three-year performance period and Compensation Committee approval; the reporting person may receive a number of shares of PepsiCo Common Stock from 0% to 175% of the PSUs granted, depending on the performance level achieved); and 3) 15,089 shares of PepsiCo Common Stock held in a personal brokerage account.
